This privacy policy has been compiled to better serve those who are concerned with how their *Personally Identifiable Information* (PII) is being used online. PII, as used in information security, is information that can be used on its own or with other information to identify, contact, or locate a single person, or to identify an individual in context. Please read our privacy policy carefully to get a clear understanding of how we collect, use, protect or otherwise handle your Personally Identifiable Information in our website and in our applications.

What personal information do we collect from visitors of our websites or users or our applications?

When do we collect information?

How do we use your information?

Do we use cookies?

Yes. Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your web browser (if you allow.) Cookies enable the site's or service provider's systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information. Cookies may be used to help us understand your preferences based on previous or current site activity, which enables us to provide you with improved services. We also use cookies to help us compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better site experiences and tools in the future.

We use cookies to:

- Understand and save your preferences for future visits
- Compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interactions in order to offer better site experiences and applications in the future. We also use trusted third party services that track this information on our behalf

You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to turn off all cookies. You do this through your web browser settings. Each browser is a little different, so look at your browser's help menu to learn the correct way to modify your cookie settings.

If you disable cookies, some features will be disabled, but you can still use the our web site.
